Dress Code Update

Here is a note from Dr. Heckel about dress code:

Greetings Parents, I know that a lot of you will be shopping for school clothes soon so, I wanted to clarify our dress code. We always encourage modesty as a biblical guideline and a medium level of nice-casual style. I know that can mean different things to different people, so in order spell out things more clearly here are some standards:

- No athletic shorts, sweat pants, tank tops, leggings, or yoga pants (though leggings can be worn under articles of clothing).
- Bermuda style denim and kaki shorts are okay as are capris.
- Sleeveless dresses and tops are okay as long as they are not spaghetti straps or camisoles.
- Jeans with holes are okay as long as they are not revealing around the buttocks and aren't overly distracting as in nearly covering the entire pant legs with holes.

- No cleavage should be revealed by clothing and no skin tight tops.
