The Heritage Marksmanship Team has competed in three competitions this fall.

On September 28, Heritage placed 8th out of 13 teams at the 2019 Willard Air Rifle Classic of the Ozarks, hosted by the Willard High School NJROTC.

On October 26, the team placed 15th out of 20 teams in the Show-Me Shoot-Out, hosted by the Ozark High School AJROTC.

Last Saturday, November 9, in Bloomington, IL the team scored a season high total of 1,967 points out of a possible 2,400. Allison Brown scored a personal best of 506/600 points. Preston Readenour improved his score by 39 points from the match two weeks prior. Sydney Suther gets the Coach's nomination for Most Improved, bringing her score up 87 points!
